

Thank you to all the exhibitors who entered under me, it was a very good entry with few absentees. After being out of showing for so long it was nice to see so many new faces around the ring. The overall standard was good, but a few of the dogs were over weight and this showed in movement. I also noticed that the ear set on some of the younger ones was very low and angulation is disappearing. I do hope that these faults will not creep into our breed and be accepted as 'the norm' as things have in the past. A little more attention to standing would help.

PUPPY DOG (4) 1st. Dunk's Zpontaineouss Zurgesteon at Zalute, At 11 months old stood solid and square with good angulation. Moved with drive, keeping its top line while doing so. Correct head with pleasing expression and good bite. BP, Res. BD. 2nd. Jarvis' Arandora Ruby Snow Bear A dog with good bone but a little over weight, did not move so well as 1. He needs a bit more control, might benefit from some ring craft. 3rd. Sopp's Laudley Cherokee Charlie

JUNIOR DOG (6) 1st. Dunk's Zpontaineouss Zurgesteon at Zalute. 2nd. Marsh's Darmaror Billy Rum Bear Stood solid with good bone. Has a good head and bite. Moved fairly well around the ring keeping his top line. He did appear to be tucking on of his front feet under on moving. 3rd. Fothergill's Donatare Star Warrior. A fair size dog with a good shape head, but he did not move as well as 2. Lacked muscle in rear legs.

NOVICE (6) 1st Dunk's Zpontaineouss Zurgesteon at Zalute. 2nd Lazarides' Kaosca Monkey Business. Did not move as well as 1, but did keep his top line on the move. Angulation did not appear very good, as he was stretched out to much. 3rd. Marsh's Darmaror Billy Rum Bear.

POST GRADUATE (6) 1st. Carvell's Venkersh Sentinel. A large dog with good bone and well muscled. A large head with pleasing expression and good bite. Moved well keeping his top line. 2nd. Lazarides' Kaosca Monkey Business. 3rd. Salmon's Penpriory Whisper of Blue. Has reasonable size bone, but is smaller in stature than 1. Has a good top line when stood, and moved well around the ring.

LIMIT (3) 1st. Carvell's Venkersh Sentinel. 2nd. Haywood & Short's Darmaror Rupert Bear. Very large dog in good coat and well boned. For a dog of this size he did not move as soundly as I would have liked. Possibly down to the warm weather and a little over weight.

OPEN DOG (4) 1st. Goodman's Zcintillating Zed at Zalute. A solid dog that stood square showing off his correct angulation. Good shape head with nice expression and good bite. Moved extremely well keeping top line. BOB (In final 8 of Group).

2nd. Woodhouse's Colmistcah White Admiral at Darmaror. Another solid dog with large head and good bone. Heavy markings which conform to breed standard. A little overweight which I feel did affect movement. 3rd. King's Cassylva Royal Musketeer

PUPPY BITCH (4) 1st. Goodman's Amariya Little Rascal. A large but feminine bitch who stood square and had good bone. Moved well keeping top line, and good angulation when stood. 2nd. Vincent's Arandora Penarosa at Cumngo. A little larger than 1 and a bit overweight. Angulation not so good as 1, but stood and moved reasonably well. 3rd. King's Ordessa Moonlight Dancer. Smaller than first two and with a little less bone. Narrow head with correct bite. Angulation fair, and moved reasonably well around ring.

JUNIOR BITCH (4) 1st. Ireland's Arandora Myss Mischief. A pretty bitch, well boned. Correct head with good bite. Stood well with good angulation. Good movement keeping top line. she showed well. RBB.

2nd. Carvell's Caselbarn Queen of Diamonds. Finer than 1, a good top line, but not so angulated at rear. Moved well around the ring. Nice head with good bite. 3rd. King's Rosemere Tarquistador. A lovely finer boned girl with a coloured head and nice expression. Did not move as well as first two.

NOVICE BITCH (7) 1st. Lazarides' Pyrite Pandora. A well boned bitch that stood very firm. Nice head and expression. Moved well around the ring holding top line. Good angulation and one of the few to have the correct tight feet. 2nd. Carvell's Caselbarn Queen of Diamonds. 3rd. Newport's Arandora Juliana at Navarrex. A finer dog than first two with little less bone. Good angulation and top line when stood. Did not move so well today.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (8) 1st. Ireland's Arandora Myss Mischief. 2nd. Parry's Penpriory Vaguely Blue of Cwmrhondda. Smaller the 1, with a nice head and expression. Good angulation when stood, but a little overweight which could have affected movement 3rd. King's Rosemere Tarquistador.

LIMIT BITCH (3) 1st. James' Gillandant White Symphony. A bitch with large bone and a fair size. Well presented with a thick coat. Angulation reasonable when stood, but did not move so well, this could have been because of the warm weather. 2nd. Ireland & Rogers' Arandora Hot Dynamite with Arazanda. Lighter boned than 1 and did not move so well. Out of coat which gave adverse appearance to top line. Fair size head with correct bite.

OPEN BITCH (4) 1st. Ireland's Arandora Christmas Eve. A nice bitch with good bone, correct angulation. Moved well keeping top line. Nice head and bite with pleasing expression. BB
