DOGS.

Puppy (2) 1. Goodman's Annanya Diamond Jubilee :- White dog true to type. Good pigmentation, tight level mouth, well-set eyes of correct amber-brown. Good bone revealing medium angulation. Level back, moved well. A little out of coat. 2. Dunk's Zpontaineouss Zurgestoon at Zalute :- White dog with blaireau on ears & skull. Just a little loose in flews at inner corner of mouth- should come right as he matures. Good pigmentation & nice expression. Level back & moved well. His litter brother just had the edge on him today.

Junior (3) 1. Wells' Darmaror Winalot Bear :- Blaireau head, true to type with amber-brown eyes. Good black pigmentation but slightly loose flews. Level back, thin on coat but still had feathering. Three months older than 2. & looked more mature for that. Moved well. 2. Dunk's Z. Z. at Zalute. 3. Lee's Luxe Kings Rhapsody.

Novice (2) 1. Dunk's Z.Z. at Zalute. Perseverance paid off & it looked the better dog on presentation.

2. Lazarides' Kaoska Monkey Bizzness:- Nice blaireau head with correct pigmentation" Excellent bone but coat was lacking & of poor texture. Presentation left a lot to be desired.

Post Grad.(7) 1. Waters' Sketrick Connoisseur :- A lovely white dog, true to type with excellent pigmentation, good mouth, correctly shaped & coloured eyes. Good feathering & length of tail. Moved well. RES.BEST DOG. 2. Salmon's Penpriory Whisper of Blue :- White dog with pale yellow blaireau. Good length of back but lacking in coat & length of tail. Moved well with power - 1. was just too good for him today. 3. Dunk's Z.Z. at Zalute.

Limit (2) 1. Woodhouse & Andrews Colmisteah White Admiral at Darmaror :- A lovely true-to-type dog with a beautiful head, dark amber eyes, good pigment and correct mouth. Strong bone & still carrying a coat with amazingly good feathering. Moved well but a little off line. 2. Pawson's Fontenay Dalwimmie :- A lovely head with a touch of blaireau on ears. Good depth of chest, well off for bone but would have liked broader loins & a better slope of the croup. Lacking coat as is to be expected at this time of the year. Eyes a little too light for me.

Open (5) 1. Goodman's Zeintillating Zed at Zalute. BEST DOG & BEST OF BREED. The last time I judged this dog it was my BEST IN SHOW from Limit & though losing some coat, still had plenty to cover & feather his well-formed body. Excellent pigmentation, beautiful expression, good amber-brown eyes & looking at his head, one sees a true-to-type Pyrenean in excellent balance. Good level back, strong bone with firm muscle. Moved with purpose & power. Showing good co-ordination. A credit to its breeder & owner. A dog to make Champion One day.

2. Cook's Cookala Golden Harvest :- Another beauty. Lovely blaireau head (more bear-type than 1) Showing nice curves in profile. Silver grey on ears. Good pigmentation & mouth with clean dentition. Short on coat, particularly on croup & losing feathering on tail. Moved a little off line today. 3. Dowdell's Ordessa Moonlit Knight.

Veteran (1) 1. Waters' Sketrick Addition. 7 1/2 years old & what a lovely veteran determined to enjoy his day out. Beautiful head, good pigmentation, tight eyes with an expression of sagacity which told me 'I've done all this before!'. Good depth of chest, excellent bone & Level back. Very good coat & feathering for this time of the year, but losing it on the tail making it appear short. Moved well.

BITCHES

Minor Puppy. (2, 1 abs.) 1. Dowdell's Ordessa Moonlight N'Stars A lovely white bitch of 7 1/2 months. Expression showed a little concern as a "Jumbo Jet" took off at full throttle at 1000ft. - & who could blame her? Nice pigmentation, correctly set ears & good mouth. Level back & signs of good angulation. Still had some puppy coat & moved very well for her age.

Puppy- (3, 1 abs.) 1. Goodman's Annanya Little Rascal. White puppy with a touch of blaireau on the ears and a real 'cheeky' expression (obviously well named.) Head in proportion with the body, good shaped eyes & pigmentation. Good conformation, straight, level back & correct length of tail. Still in coat with nice feathering. Showed keenness on the move presenting us with a well-feathered 'arrondera'- RESERVE BEST BITCH.

2. Hoolichan's Annanya Anais Anais :- Another puppy similar to 1 - a litter sister! Mostly white with a touch of blaireau on ears. Good pigmentation, nice dark eye but heavier in the head & shorter in the tail than its sister & also stood a little high at the croup, which should come right with maturity.

Junior (4, 1 abs.) 1. Hoolichan's Annanya Anais Anais. Stood better on presentation this time and moved better too. 2. Irons' Mercedes Whispering Pire :- Very nice blaireau, bear head & good pigmentation. Broad chest but a little short in body. Good feathering but presentation could have been better. 3. Hibbett's Laudley Tina Jayna Pocahontas (NAF,TAF)

Novice. (6, 1 abs.) 1. Waters & Goodsell Sketrick Calypso :- Lovely, white bitch showing true elegance, good pigmentation, nicely-proportioned body, good feathering & moved like a lady. Shows promise. 2. Lazaride's Pyrite Pandora :- Touch of blaireau on ears, good pigmentation & dark eyes. A little heavy in head in proportion with body. Excellent bone and good feathering.

3. Irons' Mercedes Whispering Pire.

Post Grad. (4) 1. Douglas' Cookala Treasured Memory of Troystar :- Nice looking bitch with blaireau on ears. True to type with good pigmentation & nice dark eyes. Level back on the move. Showed well. 2. Lazarides' Pyrite Pandora.

3. Salter's Galligh Louvie Juzon.

Limit (7, 4 abs.) 1. Dunk's Zalute Zyranasaurus :- We had competition with another Jumbo Jet on full power, so my report was scrambled! Good feminine bitch, nice head, excellent pigment, dark eyes & correct mouth. Level back, good feathering & length of tail. Moved well. 2. Pawson's Fontenay De lora :- A good body in reasonably good coat, having produced a litter in January. Touch of blaireau on head, good pigmentation. Strong bone-a real solid bitch moved with power. 3. Taylor's Traygha Aurora.

Open. (3, 2 abs.) 1. Cook's Cookala Harvest Nymph :- Stood alone but could have won even in a well-supported class. A lovely feminine bitch, true to type, excellent pigmentation & good dark eyes. Good depth of chest, tight feet & up on her toes. Kept a level back on the move after twice round the ring. In good coat with feathering on legs & tail. Well balanced & as sound as they come. BEST BITCH.

BEST OF BREED CHALLENGE - Both from OPEN with Zeintillating Zed at Zalute & Cookala Harvest Nymph fighting it out to the very end. They could change places at any time, but the dog just dominated by his presence in the ring today & took the top place.
