My thanks to the exhibitors who brought their dogs for me to go over, My general conclusion today was that dogs were better than bitches on the whole, I was disappointed to find quite a lot of light eyes in the younger dogs and in rear movement generally. Pigment was good and all dogs were clean, well presented and of excellent temperament.

PD (2) 1. Edwards Shanlimore Midnight Cowboy. Excellent bone, well bodied for age with an attractive head, nice tight lips and good eye colour. Good topline and correct angulation and movement which was controlled and easy. 2, Dowdell's Ordessa Moon Wizard, Smaller made and not as forward as 1, good bone, nice tight feet, moved soundly.

JD (3) 1. RDCC. Haresign's Caselban King of Diamonds. Excellent shape with strong bone, good angulation and superb movement. Head was a good shape with nice dark eye, excellent dentition and correct amount of stop. Although he has still to body up and grow a new jacket all the essentials were there to make a top class dog. 2, Dunk's Zpontaineous Zurgesteon at Zalute. Slightly lighter made than 1 but a good overall shape, with excellent pigment and tight eye. Not as firm in movement but time is on his side. 3. Fothergill's Donatare Star Warrior. Strongly built dog, well bodied for age, with excellent coat texture. Could have a tighter mouth and was moving closer behind.

ND (3) 1. Zpontaineouss Zurgesteon at Z. 2. Lazarides Kaosca Monkey Business. Solid, well made dog, angulation not quite as good as 1, with a slightly lighter eye. Excellent topline and moving freely. 3. D Star Warrior.

PGD (9) A very strong class. Some nice dogs went without cards. 1. Ireland's Red Embers Mr Chip at Arandora. Not the heaviest of dogs, but very well balanced with excellent angulation, good feet. Head had a dark tight eye good mouth and correct stop. Moved with freedom and power. 2. Lewis's Shayshatow Diamond Boy. Still a little immature in body, but very promising with correct angulation and excellent shoulder. Head attractive and with correct stop. Covered the ground easily. 3. Salmon's Penpriory Whisper of Blue. All white, but with a reasonable eye colour, good mouth with tight lips. Moved freely, but a little close behind.

LD (4) 1. Merrick's Granchester Fella. Excellent head and dentition, level topline, and good angulation. Flowing movement and good expression. 2. Pawson's Fontenay Dalwinnie. Solidly built dog with a good front although I would have liked a little more rear angulation. Well handled with excellent feet for such a big dog and kept his topline well on the move. 3. Woodhouse's Colmisteah White Admiral at Darmaror. A very nice shaped dog with excellent coat, and attractive head. Needs to lose some weight.

OD (8, 2abs) 1. DCC & BOB Pollard's Ch Gillandant Star Accolade. Outstanding for his shape, balance and movement. Nothing exaggerated or underdone, with an attractive head and lovely free movement. Top class condition and presentation, a pleasure

to go over. 2. Gribble's Ir Ch Kaosca Hob Goblin. Slightly lighter in build, but well put together with a beautiful head. Moved well and pressed for the RCC but I preferred the rear angulation of the junior dog.

3. Goodman's Zcintillating Zed at Zalute. Tall dog, who has excellent pigment, good head shape, nice dark eye and is well put together, not as well proportioned as the first two, but moved very well.

PB(5) 1. Edwards Shanlimore Marie. Litter sister to the PD winner. Same excellent build with everything in harmony, height, length, bone, body, angulation, BP beating her brother with her beautiful expression. 2. Tadd's Shanlimore Merry Maid. Another litter sister, not quite as forward as 1 but is similar in shape with an attractive head and good movement.

3. Pawson's Fontenay Izzabella. Lovely chunky puppy, just 6 months with excellent bone, nice tight mouth with good dentition. All 3 puppies had the same sire, Lydaub Superior, obviously an excellent producer.

JB (4, 1 ab) 1. Goodman's Annanya Little Rascal. Very mature for age with excellent bone and body, with attractive head, nice dark eye, but rear movement could be better.

2. Edlin's Rosemere Urszula. Well angulated bitch with an excellent topline. Most attractive head and expression, well proportioned, but not cooperating with her handler today. 3. De Pledge's Kalkasi Island Pandora of Pyrhaven. At that in between stage, needs more time to come together.

NB (1) 1. Lazarides Pyrite Pandora. Good size and adequate bone, with an excellent topline. Dark eye, with particularly expressive eye. Moved well.

PGB (11, 4Ab) 1. Haresign's Joleanor Not T'nite Josefene at Caselbarn. Really solidly built girl, with a beautiful head, excellent pigment and tight, dark eye. Good bone and angulation, moved very well. Considered for RCC but just a shade wide in front.

2. Parry's Penpriory Vaguely Blue O'Cwmrhondda. Another really well made bitch. Movement was excellent despite carrying a little too much weight. Head is most attractive with tight lips, correct dentition and nice dark eye. 3. Edlin's Rosemere

LB (8, 2Ab) 1. BCC. Rosemere Winter's Legacy De Niavarnais. Caught my eye as soon as she moved round the ring, her action was so free and smooth. On going over her she did not disappoint, being correctly constructed, with excellent bone, good angulation and an attractive well made head. Pigment was good and eye and expression lovely. With another year to body up I'm sure she will be even better, but she was a clear and worthy winner here. I'm sure her 3rd will come soon. 2. Edwards Shanlimore Lucille. A dog of good construction and sound as a bell. Good topline and angulation, correct coat

and super pigment. Would like a tighter eye. 3. Ireland's Arandora Hot Dynamite With Arazanda. In the nude as far as coat was concerned, but took her place here with excellent construction and sound movement.

OB (4, 2Ab) 1. RBCC Edwards Ch Shanlimore Karousel. Well bodied bitch of good size with correct angulation, good shoulder and attractive head. Although not cooperating on the move with her handler, she did move soundly and her excellent proportions and soundness of construction could not be denied. 2. Pawson's Fontenay De Lora. Strong well made bitch with good bone, and an attractive eye.
