1st / Maggs Ch. Zalute Zerendipitee of Dewyche JW.ShCM. 7 ½ yr old male who has still got lots to like about him, nice eye which was of good colour and shape, teeth were clean but his age was beginning to show in the bottom row in that they were not very straight and all incisors had dropped. Good shoulders into straight moving front, very good top line which was held on the move, back movement a little close but straight. Very well muscled and fit looked as if he could go all day. Finished of in a very good jacket. **RBD**

2nd / Denyer's Ch. Milenjohy Lord Brogan of Batrapyr ShCM. A 8 ½ boy of good substance, lovely head, good eye of very gentle expression, just the hint of a third eyelid showing, very tight cat feet, his movement was a bit sluggish but I put this down to the weather being quite warm and the fact that he was a little overweight, which lost it on the day to the 1st

3rd / Fieldhouse's Boramha Marie-France at Pyrenmount A 10 year girl old that looks very good for her age, very gentle head, good eye expression, pigment beginning to fade, flews a little lose, one of the few here today that had the hook in the tail. Movement was not her forte today and I think she had other things on her mind like lying in the shade and dreaming of the mountains.

PD 3 (1)

1st / Shaw's Jazanah Jaunty 10 month old white boy of good size, super head with no lumps or bumps, just a gentle stop into a strong muzzle, good tight mouth, full dentition and scissor bite, eyes of good shape but a little dark losing some of the expression, wonderful pigment, needs to grow into his ears a little but they are of correct shape and well placed, Movement let him down today as I have seen him move better, well muscled for age. Good hook, Shown in good, clean, well groomed coat. **BPD**

2nd / Meakin's Jazanah Josephinite Litter brother to 1st and much the same applies, slightly heavier in bone, and head more pronounced in stop, movement was better,- just preferred 1st over all presentation and muscle tone, but could change places on another day.

1st / Magg's Gillandant Kathy's Clown of Dewyche. A tall Blaireau 15 month old very forward lad, full dentition, good head although eyebrows a little prominent, eyes are of good colour and shape, ears could be a little on the large size but he still has a lot of maturing to do in that area, would like tighter flews, nice length of neck into good lay of shoulder giving a good extension on his movement up front, good top line, well placed tail with good hook, a little straight in stifle and hock for me, straight going and returning, good tight feet and good hock length giving a nice length of leg. well muscled thighs, Presented in good double coat of pristine condition. **BD & BIS**

2nd / Shaws Jazanah Jaunty.

3rd Jones Gillandant Silent Whisper, Litter brother to my BIS this boy has a lovely head with a good eye shape and colour, good ear placement, flews were a little loose, he had left his coat at home, not quite so well muscled as 1&2 and not moving as well as I have seen him, rather narrow in front, good hook in tail and good strong dew claws set nice and low.

1st / Maggs Gillandant Kath's Clown of Dewyche.

2nd / Ford's Kalkasi Carefree at Desalazara, 18 month old tall blaireau boy , head a little strong for me but good eye and colour, eyebrows showing a little, good ear set and size, strong neck into reasonable shoulders and good topline nice broad back nice tail set with good hook, lovely tight feet. Would like a little more heart room. Moved out well although a little close behind.

1st / Magg's G Kathy's Clown of Dewyche

2nd / Baverstock's Kalkasi Magical MasqueradeJW. A. 2 ½ year old tall blaireau boy, with a very pleasing outline such a pity to come up against 1st, slightly more stop, level bite, lovely eye shape although a little light, very good pigment, just the right amount of angulation to upper arm, would like a little more width of front, good top line held well on the move, good working weather proof coat of the desired texture, turned out in pristine condition both in muscle and fitness.

3rd / Whitfield's Penpriory New Statesman of Dennaje shCM I have always admired this 3 ½ year old wolf grey boy but to day was not his day, he has everything going for him in his lovely head with well placed eyes with good colour small neat ears, lovely gentle expression, nothing over done on him, but he just did not have that sparkle that he has had in the past, movement was forced, and he did just not want to be there today.

OD 2 (1wd)

1st Baverstock's Ch Kalkasi Willows Surprise JW shCM 4 ½ year old tall blaireau boy look lovely standing with good angulation, well placed eye and ear with good expression, lovely hook in tail, nice low strong dew claws, level top line which was kept on the move, movement was disappointing, very narrow in front which resulted in him flipping his front feet, I have seen this boy move with much more enthusiasm, in saying that he had the best coat of the day.

PB 2 (1)

1st / Thompson's Jazanah Jade, What a lovely 10 month old all white bitch, litter sister to the boy pups, what a cracking litter, very feminine head, lovely eye, with correct colour and shape, good scissor bite, well filled in under the eye, small flat good shaped ear, good length of neck leading on to nice lay of shoulder and top line which was kept on the move, beautiful daisy cutting steps which were performed with gracefulness not seen before here today, angulation of just the right amount, coat a little soft and needed a little more of it, The only thing that kept her off the top spots was her lack of maturity. one to watch. **BPIS.**

JB 2 (1)

1st / Ford's Gillandant Kiss And Tell at Desalazara. Stood alone but a very nice 15 month old well up on her pasterns, adequate angulation and good head, would like to see slightly darker eye, and less eyebrow, flews could be tighter, level bite, moved very well around the ring holding a good topline, good length of leg and tight feet.

1st / Baverstock's Kalkasi Running Free A lovely 15 month old girl, shorter coupled very compact and full of quality, blaireau coat which was in good condition and of the correct texture, a very appealing head of good proportions with good pigment, lovely eye of correct size and shape, good head with no eyebrows and a very gentle stop that lead to full dentition and a scissor bite strong neck which lead into good top line held on the move, movement could have been a little more positive, in saying that she had everything in the right place, and showed well, just wished she was a little taller. **RBB**

2nd / Jones Shanlimore Moon Crystal. At nearly 3 years old this lovely girl has a very feminine head, little round and light in the eyes, pigment the blackest I have seen to day, lovely tight feet, little over angulated which did not help her backend movement, she left her coat at home but what was there was clean, lovely hook in tail.

3rd / Ford's Kalkasi Magical Beauty at Desalazara. Another very nice bitch from this stable of 2 ½ years of age, little too much stop for me but the eye and ear placement correct, lovely scissor bite, bit narrow in front, good bone, movement a little erratic at the back, lovely tight feet.

1st / Baverstock's Kalkasi Running Free.

2nd / Ford's Gillandant Kiss And Tell.

3rd / Terry's Zalute Ztatusqowoutonawim. A 3 year old very nice blaireau girl who really has moved better, to day she was not co-operating with her handler, quite a tall girl with lots to like, wonderful pigment well kept top line when she did move properly, good angulation, feet a little long, very feminine, just needs more coat.

LB 4

1st / Flounders Sketrick Izzianette at Lakamoni, A beautiful all feminine 2 ½ year old white girl of great proportions, all feminine head of correct eye, ear, and length of muzzle, good bite, full dentition, good pigment, shoulder angulation correct good length of leg, rear movement not as sound as I would have liked due to the fact that the muscles are not as toned as they should be for her age, also handler tends to stand her with her hind legs too far apart there fore making her look cow hocked which she is not. Please watch this and also slow down on movement, too fast a movement throws her all out of line and she then tends to crab. **BB.**

RBIS BOS.

2nd / Hill's Cluny Chanteuse, A 6 year old tall blaireau girl with good pigment, good eye, ear placement and good fill, although did not want to move, - only in one direction, - towards the exit, when she did move she was true, sound and well balanced, good top line which she held on the move on lovely tight feet.

3rd / Wilcock's Kalkasi Magical Flare at Penelley. A different type to 1&2 altogether stockier and shorter coupled girl of 2 ½ years old, lots to like about her head a little heavy for me but a well placed eye of good colour and good fill under, small good shaped ear set on well, little up right in shoulders making her movement a bit hackney, best feet of the day in being tight and cat like, lovely clean coat and good texture.

OB 1

1st / Baverstock's Kalkasi Misty Willow JW A very nice 4 ½ year old lady of very good bone, nice size, and well muscled, lovely head shape would have like a little less stop, little light in eye but good shape, correct placement of ear of nice size and shape, good tight flews, full dentition, rather narrow in front which affected her front movement, good double coat and harsh to the touch, lovely hook in tail.
